Having only 2.5% of the world's geographic area and 1.85% of the world's forest area, we have 17% of world's population and 18% of livestock population. By considering all these aspects, it is imperative to preserve the forests and manage them sustainably so as to ensure secure livelihood of the forest dependent communities as well as conserving our biological diversity.

In this context, the present seminar has been organized by the Department of Zoology. Eminent Scientists from reputed research institutes are invited to deliver lectures on current issues of forest resource management. It is believed that this seminar will make an impact on the young minds about the conservation of forest resources for the well being of our future generations.
