Nadar and Mr. V.A.Rathna Nadar established V.H.N.S.N.College on 11<sup>th</sup>August, 1947 with that donation amount.

It imparts soft skills and employability training to the students. Conducted a written test and an online test titled “Explore Yourself” to improve students' Aptitude skills, which are essential to get a job today. Our college organized a workshop for students in association National Institute of Banking, Madurai. And also conducted Mock Interview (Model Interview) for the students. Conducted Essay writing and Speech competitions in English. Also provides excellent training to students in Resume Preparation, HR Interview, Body



Language, Aptitude and Communication in English. It collects Bio-data from the students and registers them in the computer and sends that record to many reputed companies and gives them job opportunities. So far, 1788 placements have been given to the students through this Cell. It is significant that our students have been placed in companies like TCS and Wipro this year.

ELITE FORUM is an important part of the placement system. P. Nagendra Vel is the placement officer as well as the coordinator of this organization. As other members of this organization are Dr. M. Anna Lakshmi , Mr. R. Prem Shankar and Mr. N.G.S. Parameswaran. This organization helps the students to find out their individual talent and bring it out and develop it. At every Wednesday, students come to the MCA auditorium after 4 pm, to exhibit their individual talents. Stamp Collection, Coin Collection, Embroidery, Photography, Doll Making, Jewel Making, Silambattam, Solo Dance, Group Dance, Folk Dance, Classical Dance, Modern Dance, Singing, Drawing, Painting, Mimicry, Rangoli, Karate, Yoga, Oratory, Poetry, Writing etc., Students show their skills and get appreciation.

#### **PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT CELL**

In order to develop the personality of the girl students in our college, the organization named "Personality Development Cell" is functioning, which coordinated by our teaching faculties Mrs. J. Nagasudha, Dr. S. Maheshwari and Dr. Shanthi. This organization conducts coaching classes for first year undergraduate students on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4.05 pm to 5.30 pm. The guest lectures on ' Stress management', 'Aram seya virumbu', 'Giving wings to your ambition', 'Positive Attitude', 'The Art of Communication is the language of leadership', 'Don't judge a person by their appearance', 'Nalam Un kaiyil', 'Penmai', 'Manathil Uruthivandum', 'Penna Nee Valga', 'Ulagam Un Kaiyil' etc., were delivered by our teaching staff from various departments and given training to the students with speakers from various fields.

Along with this, the various competitions like 'Paper presentation', 'Just a minute' and 'Picture talk' were conducted to improve the skills of the students and prizes were given to the winning students. Apart from these Special Training and Counselling are being provided to the students to participate in the seminars, workshops and competitive exams held in other colleges. This system is providing ideas in a systematic manner and is functioning well so that the students can travel in the ideal path with a clear vision and set their future in a good way.

## **YOUTH RED CROSS**

The Youth Red Cross Society in our college is coordinated by Professors Dr. G. Ravi, Dr. A. Baskaran, and G. Mariselvam.

In this academic year, this association organized four blood donation camps in our college campus in collaboration with RRC, NCC, NSS and Virudhunagar Ooncha V. Thanasamy - Parimaladevi Blood Bank on 18.07.2018, 19.09.2018, 24.10.2018 and 07.12.2018. Our college students participated enthusiastically and donated 386 units of life-saving medicinal blood. Apart from this, the blood bank in the Virudhunagar Government Hospital was short of blood, so our college students donated blood to the Government Hospital on 11.10.2018 and 25.10.2018. Besides our students have visited various hospitals for the urgent needs of patients and have donated 600 units of blood till date.

This is the 8<sup>th</sup> year for our college which has been selected as the college with the highest number of blood donors in Virudhunagar district and Jam Nagar O.T.A.V. Nagaratna Nadar Memorial Trophy has been awarded. 51 saplings are being planted and maintained in our college campus in commemoration of our college ranking of 51<sup>st</sup> in NIRF. Cleaning the college campus has been taken up ahead of the visit of the NAAC team.

## **RED RIBBON CLUB (RRC)**

In our college RRC is functioning well under the supervision of Dr.N.Raman and Dr.M.Annalakshmi.

This organization has 109 students in the first year of undergraduate and 82 students in the second year of undergraduate, who are doing the main tasks of raising awareness about AIDS and honouring blood donation. Field Work and Lectures on AIDS are held every week on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Virudhunagar Ooncha V. Dhanasamy-Parimala Devi Trust, in

collaboration with YRC, NCC and NSS of our college, conducted many blood donation camps. And various seminars are conducted to develop the intellectual skills of the students.

On 11.07.2018, the introductory meeting about RRC was conducted under the presence of our college principal Dr. P. Sundharapandian. Mr. A. Muthuramalingam, ICTC Consultant, Virudhunagar Government Hospital, was invited as chief guest. On 13.07.2018, 15.08.2018, 19.09.2018 and 24.10.2018 our college conducted blood donation camps in association with YRC. Various programs were held on 13.12.2018 to celebrate Youth Day. Mainly our college RRC and TANSACS-DAPCO, Virudhunagar organized a very successful HIV and TB testing camp. College principal Dr.P.Sundarapandian inaugurated the camp in which Supervisor of Virudhunagar District AIDS Control Corporation Mr. M. Ayyanar, Virudhunagar District Resource Adolescent Project Coordinator Mrs. Amala, Virudhunagar District Government Hospital ICTC Consultant Mr. A. Muthuramalingam, ART Consultant Mr. B. Kannan, and Dr. Akash were in this camp. 1360 students were tested in a single day which was a remarkable event in this camp.

Mr. A. Muthuramalingam conducted classes for three days on the topic of “Celebrating Life” for the first year students from 4.00 pm to 6.00 pm. And our RRC students participated in the Independence Day function, held in our college on 15.08.2018 and the Republic Day function held on 26.01.2019 and graced the occasion.

On 05.02.2019 students visited ICTC, ART, STI and Blood Bank in Virudhunagar District Hospital and discussed with the doctors and consultants there. Also, they visited the nearby Virudhunagar District AIDS Society and discussed with them.

### **CONSUMER FORUM**

In our college, the Consumer Forum is functioning with Dr.C.Cheladhurai, Assistant Professor of Commerce, as the coordinator.

## **PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION**
