In 1940s, Getting a college admission in Madurai had been the most challenging phase for every student.In 1947, A. Lakshmana Sami – Vice-Chancellor of Chennai University made an announcement, to relax the rules and regulations to promote the establishment of autonomous colleges.During the Nadar community conference at Kovilpatti, Raavsahib P.S.Chidambara Nadar proposed the idea of establishment of an educational institution at Virudhunagar and added that Raav Bahadur M.S.P. SenthikumaraNadar's willingness to donate ₹ 2 lakhs for it.

With arduous effort, the renowned persons of Virudhunagar Mr. W.P.A. ChoundarapandiyanNadar,Mr. V.V. Shanmuga Nadar, MrP.S. Chidambara Nadar, Mr. M.S.P. Nadar and Mr. V.A. Rathna Nadar established V.H.N.S.N. College on 11<sup>th</sup>August, 1947 with that donation amount.

The Institution started with the meagre strength of around 100 students and the sublime doctrine is to provide "LowCost Access to High Quality Education". Then, the Institution has attained tremendous progress by establishing many research centres in various departments. #### Significant Activities of the year 2019 - 2020

- With great pleasure, I inform that our college has secured 63<sup>rd</sup> position in the National Institutional Ranking Framework conducted by Ministry of Human Resource and Development, Government of India.
- Under the self-financing stream, new courses in BBA, B. Sc in Physical Education and B. Voc in Renewable Energy were started in this academic year.
- Our management has procured new computers to the tune of Rs. 2,92.500 for various departments. Wooden furniture was purchased for Rs. 4,33,200. Software's and forty batteries were purchased for Rs.3,28,431 and Rs.1,70,000 respectively. Rs.83,000 was waived to motivate the students of physical education department. Rs. 1,62,000 was distributed as scholarship to the students under the endowment HOPE

(Helping Others Pursue Education). For second year post-graduate students, an amount of Rs.2000 each was sanctioned as project assistance fee.

• 1191 first year students attended the examination conducted by Vivekananda Kendra. The examination facilitated the students to understand the life of Vivekananda and to appreciate Indian culture. An amount of Rs. 35.730 was met out by our management to motivate the students.

- During this year, staff members who are research supervisors have successfully guided 26 research scholars to get doctoral degree. Our college librarian Dr. G. Amutha guided 5 research scholars to attain doctorate degree. Retired professor Dr. L. Amal Raj guided 4 research scholars to get doctorate degree. Dr. S. Sekar Subramaniam lead 3 research scholars to doctorate degree and Dr. N. Neelamegam conducted 1 research scholar to doctorate degree. Dr. J. Samuel Kirubakaran, Dr.D. Christopher Durairaj, Dr.A.K. Muthusamy, and Dr. M. Kannan piloted 2 research scholars to doctorate degree respectively. Dr.N.Raman and Dr.V.Muthuraj supervised a research scholar to doctorate degree.
- This year, our college faculties N. Vijayalakshmi, A. Riswana and M.S. Saravanan acquired doctoral degree in their respective disciplines.
- Our institution was adjudged the best college this year by Idhayam G Group of companies.
- Our college principal acted as a peer committee member of NAAC team twice, this year. In Andhra Pradesh, he visited Bheemavaram KGRL college and Thirupathi SEICOM college on 18.07.2019 and 19.07.2019.
- Dr. R. Palaniappan and Dr. A. Sakthivel are functioning effectively as the Controller and Joint-controller of examinations. Keeping the interests of students in mind, they published the results of the odd semester on December 5<sup>th</sup> and the results of the even semester on 24<sup>th</sup> May in our college website and Android application. The office of the controller of examinations conducts supplementary examinations immediately after the summative examinations for helping the students who could not clear their papers in their first attempt. This system helps the students to join higher education without delay. The method of testing and evaluation adopted by the office of controller of examinations is appreciated by all.
- Deans of our college are doing a commendable job for the development of our college.
  Dr. R. Selvam acts as the dean of Arts, Dr. K. Nagarajan is the dean of Science, Dr. A.
  Sarathi looks after the dean office for Internals, Dr. P. Sarathy is serving as the dean for Students' Services and Dr. N. Jeyakumaran takes care of Dean office of Research.

- For the first time in the history of our college, an international workshop on Emerging Trends in Science and Social Science was conducted at Kuala Lumpur, the capital of Malaysia on 03.05.2019 and 04.05.2019. Our principal and professors along with faculties from various countries participated in it. Dr. P. Mehalingam was the coordinator of the programme.
- The Placement cell of our college offers guidance and training besides conducting campus interviews. Mr. P. Nagendravel plays an indispensable role as the placement officer. Multi-national companies like TCS, CTS, WIPRO, ASPIRE and SYNTEL recruited 1884 students through campus interview.
- A new set of 1300 books were purchased for our college library taking the total number of books to 106912. The overall number of books including e-books in our library is119471. An anti-plagiarism software, URKUND is installed at the cost of 85,000. More than 84 journals were renewed at the cost of Rs.1,59,046. Under the auspice of library, a book exhibition was conducted on 28.08.2019 and 29.08.2019. V-zine, an electronic magazine was published twice this year by our college library.
