Major Events in 2021-2022

* This year our college administration has purchased new computers at a cost of Rs.3, 60,050/- for the multi-purpose use of the college. Wood floors have been purchased at a cost of Rs.2, 76,000/- and software at a cost of Rs.2, 39,500/-. In addition, fee concession of Rs.1, 30,100/- has been given to four students of Physical Education Department.

*Considering the demand&future of Power Connections on Our College Campus and following the instructions of the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, all the existing power lines have been integrated into a single high pressure power line (HT Line with 450 KVA Maximum Demand) at a cost of Rs. 1, 65, 00,000/- (Rupees One Crore Sixty Five Lakhs only) and the works have been started and are in progress

*This year is being celebrated as the 75th anniversary of the college. A fund of Rs.15, 00,000/- was allocated by the college management for the celebration and various programs were held very well.

*A special envelope bearing the college stamp was released on 11.08.2021 in association with the Department of Posts to mark the 75thyear of the college. And a special cancellation stamp was also issued on that day. Virudhunagar district Collector Mr. J. Meghnatha Reddy was present as special guest on the occasion.

*HOPE (Helping Others Pursue Education) Rs.46, 000/- has been given to 46 students at the rate of Rs.1, 000/- each by our college management. Also 92,000/- has been given by our

college management to 92 students at the rate of Rs.1000 for research Article writing for final year students in the name of PASS (Project Assistance for Students).

*This year our college administration has given Rs.54, 000/- as incentive to 7 professors under the SEED MONEY program to encourage the research work of the teachers.

*A new urinal and toilet are being constructed at the rear of the Commerce Department for the use of students this year.

* It is planned to install electric lights in the Aruppukottai entrance area for students for Rs 3, 00,000/-

* This year the Zoology Department Museum infrastructure facilities of our college have been improved and its standard has been raised internationally.

* On the occasion of the 75th anniversary celebration of our college, logo bearing 75 will be installed at the front of our college at a cost of Rs.15, 00,000/- lakh.

* In this academic year 5 books have been published by our college professors. College Principal Dr. P. SundaraPandian along with Dr. S. Muthulakshmi and Dr. T. Vijayakumar, New Delhi-based Sultan Chand has written a book entitled Research Methodology & Applications of SPSS in Social Science Research. Also, College Principal Dr. P. Sundara Pandian, Dr. N. Jayakumaran and Dr. J. Pandiyarajan together have written Recent Advances in Arts, Science and Social Sciences.Principal Dr. P. Sundara Pandian and Dr. S. Prakash have written Disaster Management & First Aid Guide. Biological Research in 2021: Aspects and Prospects have been written by Dr. S. Jayakumar. Dr. D. SelvaSankaran has written the book "Glass Sound"

*This academic year many professors in our college have acted as research mentors and produced 16 PhD researchers. Retired Professor Dr. S. Shekhar Subramanian has produced 2 Research scholars, Dr. P. Ananthasayanam 1 Research Scholar; Dr. J. Samuel Kirubahar has produced 3 research scholars, Dr. A. Selvam 2 research scholars, Dr. N. Raman, Dr. A.K. Muthuchamy, Dr. N. Jayakumaran, Dr. V. Muthuraj, Dr. S. Karuthapandian, Dr. S. Muthuramkumar, Dr. T. Vijayakumar, Dr. K. Pushpaveni each produced 1 Ph.D. Scholar.

*Our college professors Dr. T. Nithya, Dr. K. Jyotheeswari, Dr. S. RajeevGandhi, Dr. A. Mohanraj, Dr. S. Palperumal, Dr. S. Tamilselvi have received their PhD degrees this year.

*This year 16 students have registered in our college for Ph.D.

*Dr. R. Palaniappan as the Controller of Examination of our college and Dr. A. Sakthivel as the Joint Controller of Examinations are working effectively. Considering the welfare of the students, this year's examinations have been well conducted through the internet even when the college is not functioning due to the corona virus. In order not to affect the students, a professor

from each department has been appointed and the risks of taking the exam online have been addressed and the exam results have been published on March 11 on the college website and Android application so that the students can easily see them. Students who failed in the final examination are immediately given a joint examination and are encouraged to join their higher studies. And the organizational system followed in our Examination is found to be the best and one that is appreciated by all.

*The college leaders (Deans) are playing a major role in the autonomous management of our college and in the development of the college. Dr. M. Meenadevi as Dean of Arts, Dr. K. Nagarajan as Dean of Science, Dr. N. Jayakumaran as Dean of Research, Dr. A. Sarathy as Dean of Internal Exam Assessment and Dr. P. Sami as Dean of Student Services are working effectively.

*Placement Cell is working well to provide job opportunity to the students studying in our college. Dr. P. Meghalingam is in charge of this. Wipro Technologies, Tamilnad Mercantile Bank Ltd., Deloitte, Purple Slate, have conducted campus interview and has given 438 job placement orders so far this year.

*Mega Job Offer job camp was held in our college on 05.03.2022. 28 companies visited the college and 2000 students participated in it. 191 students from our college and 133 students from other colleges have received the appointment order in the camp.

*In our college, the coaching classes for bank exam are going on from 09.03.2022. It is noteworthy that 156 students are benefiting from this.

*Chennai based Purpleslate company conducted campus interview. It is noteworthy that S. Manojkumar and K. Vijayaraghavan, students of third year computer science in our college, received appointment order and got a job offer with an annual salary Rs.5,00,000/-.

*Based on the MoU signed by our college with DCE Technology, a student named G.Veeramani, II MCA., is working part-time in the company while studying and receiving a training allowance of Rs.30, 000/- per month. Two more students received training allowance of Rs.5, 000/- per month.7 students from IT department received training allowance of Rs.5,000/- based on MoU with Clarium Tech Pvt., Ltd., &Men The Technologies Pvt., Ltd.,

*New books were purchased for our college library this year. Hindi books in separate register and donated books 10743 have been loaded in main library register and the number of books has increased to 118772 books at present. Subscription of magazines for Rs.50, 000/- was renewed. DELNET, NLIST and Chennai US Consulate Library Membership was renewed at a cost of Rs.22, 600/-. A Webinar was conducted on July 23, 2021 on Create of Academic Accounts. On August 15, 2021, a district level book review competition was conducted and prizes were distributed to the students. Also, a book review competition was conducted on behalf of our college founder's festival and prizes were given to the winning students on 08.01.2022. On

behalf of Library Club, Readers Club, National Digital Library Club a Guest Lecture Program was organized. "Research Hub" called E- Resource Store was newly launched research papers completed by our college faculty was collected and maintained.

*In view of this year's 75th year of the college, the program of planting a tree every day is going on in the college for 365 days. So far this year alone, 800 saplings have been planted in the college and are being well maintained.

*The Chairman of the Municipal Council of our city Mr. S.R.S.R. Madhavan, on behalf of the Department of English attended the Alumni Association program held on 01.04.2022 and delivered a keynote address.

* Our college has been awarded as the best college in adopting the best villages by PEARL Foundation.

*This year our college participated in the Longest Multinational Confluence world record series event at Puduchery's research campus on 03.10.2021.

*Our College participated in the 1200-hour International Series Webinar for Alist World Achievement organized by Tamilnadu Teacher Education University on 04.09.2021 on the topic of 21st Century Books and on 03.10.2021 on the topic of Yogic Art in Biodiversity.

*It is noteworthy that B. Abinesh Kumar, a second year mathematics student of our college won the third prize in the National Yogasana Competition organized by NYSF Institute under Central Govt., Odisha.

*Union Ministry of Human Resource Development is implementing the Educational Assistance Scheme with the aim of not hindering the higher education of the economically backward students who are excelling in junior first year degree course in our college. 213 students have been selected under this scheme. 10,000/- per annum for 3 years to undergraduate students selected under this scheme and 20,000/- per annum to master's degree students for two years. The total amount is Rs.21, 30,000/-. This scholarship is made available to the students by the tireless efforts of the teachers. It is worth mentioning that Dr. P.Mehalingam is incharge of the central government's educational assistance.

• The college has applied for 100 students to get assistance under the one girl child assistance scheme for post graduate students in the college, the Beedy circulating worker financial assistance scheme for the first and second year students and the minority welfare assistance scheme for the students. It is also worth noting that all central government research programs and university research programs are financed through public fund management.

- This year the college anthem composed by our old student Mr. D. Enosus and lyrics written by our professor Dr. D. Selvasankaran and sung by our professors and students is a remarkable one.
- This year E-Studio has been started in our college with modern facilities. Lectures of the professors related to the curriculum that are useful to the students are recorded in this studio as sound and light and uploaded on YouTube. More than 650 video collections have been uploaded so far. Dr. M. Kannan, Department of Zoology, is in-charge.
- Bangalore based Ekalaiv Tech Pvt. Ltd., Virudhunagar District Cluster of Colleges in History, SRNM College, AlwarKurichi Sri ParamaKalyani College, Madurai American College, Chennai Menthee Technologies, Mangaiyarkarasi College, Madurai, Sri Marutham Agro Biotech, Amizhth Techno Solutions Pvt. Ltd., MoUs have been made with colleges and institutes to carry out various research work.
- In order to create awareness among our college students about the need of agriculture and to inculcate in the students the attitude of research related to agriculture, 2 types of paddy were planted in 2 acres of land in our college this year and agriculture was carried out. It is noteworthy that the event was entirely organized and maintained by the college professors and students.

It is also noteworthy that on that day, a business market was conducted by the students and more than one lakh transactions were made.
- Various competitions were held. The competitions were based on various concepts to promote students' artistic finesse, skills, language pronunciation and language usage. It is noteworthy that Dr. Y. Vidya, Professor, Department of English, made the arrangements for the competition.

- A Scheme called One Book One Alumini has been introduced by our college alumni association and is progressing well with the idea that alumni should donate at least one book to the college.
