It is to be noted that as the examination timings have been changed, the examination results are released as soon as possible within a maximum of 1 week from the date of examination.
- * 20 marks for written test out of 25 for internal assessment test is divided into 10 marks for written test and 10 marks for ERL (online 1 mark test). This ERL exam is conducted in continuous assessment mode 5 times throughout the semester and is included in the students' internal assessment.
