•	To meet the evolving need of electricity and in accordance to the norms of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board, all the electric connections were integrated into a single high voltage power (HT Line with 450KVA Maximum Demand) with an expense of around ₹ 1,65,00,000.
•	New computers that worth ₹ 31,55,700 have been purchased for multi-purpose use. Also, wooden furniture that cost around ₹ 2,78,740 have been purchased. Furthermore, concessions in fee were provided for the Physical Education students at the cost of ₹ 1,25,500.
•	CCTV Camera have been purchased that cost around ₹ 3,07,030.
•	Three classrooms have been constructed on the first floor of the Physical Education Department at a cost of ₹ 21,68,876.
•	Tar road have been constructed at a cost of ₹ 28,10,000 for the benefit of students and teachers.
•	All buildings have been white washed.
•	Maintenance and repair work that cost ₹48,98,076/- have been done.
•	IQAC of our college has been shifted to an air-conditioned room and equipped with modern facilities.
•	Dr. A. Shanmugavel, Associate professor of physics department have been elected as a member of Regents Board in Madurai Kamaraj University.
•	Our college management have sanctioned ₹ 1,50,000 for the research work by students and teachers under the scheme “ PASS (Project Assistance for Students) “ and “ SEED MONEY “.
•	Our college management have sanctioned ₹ 46,000 under the scheme “ HOPE (Helping Others Pursue Education) “ and 46 students have been benefited getting ₹1000 each. Furthermore, Our college management have given ₹ 92,000 under the scheme “PASS (Project Assistance for Students) “ to 92 final year students for their research work.

•	To test the student's subject knowledge, an online test (MCQ) is conducted before the written test and the results are published along with the external and internal exam results, on 6th July and 12th December in our college website and android application. For the students who fail in the semester examination, the joint examination will be conducted immediately and results were declared within a short period of time.
•	For the convenience of students, QR code have been printed in both of their the transfer and attendance certificate from this academic year. Other certificates like conduct, bonafide and course certificates have been computerized.
•	Marks allocated for assignment is changed to open book test from this academic year. This encourages students to read books and efficient use of the library.
•	Training classes have been conducted on sports, dance, and technical knowledge under the programme "One Skill One Student", to in still best practices.
•	Dr. A. Sarathy, College Principal has been appointed as the Chief Invigilator of Examination and Dr. N. Prithivikumaran as Additional Superintendent for post-graduation and Dr. K. •	District level Aptitude test for 12 th students has been conducted for the 16 th consecutive year. 2137 students from twenty five Government and Matriculation schools participated in it. The coordinators Dr.V.Manohar, Dr.A.Vijayakumar, Dr. M. Kannan organized the entire event.															
•	Dr. M. Nagarajan, Head of Zoology Department, received a grant from Indian Patent Society for the use of plant leaf extract to kill crop-damaging insects.															
•	50 new books have been added to our college library that cost around ₹ 29,015. 777 books have been received as gifts. Currently, the number of books has been raised to 120862. New magazines have been purchased at a cost of ₹ 23,244. 17 periodical subscriptions were renewed at a cost of ₹ 30,949. Also, N-LIST, DELNET & American Consulate library subscriptions were renewed at a cost of ₹.22.470.															
•	Under Savitri Bhai Jyothirao Phule Research Scheme and Central Government Tribal Welfare Scheme, a family with single girl child, E. Nivetha is getting ₹31,000 as monthly allowance.															
•	Under New Delhi University Board of Trustees- PG Scholarship for University Rank Holders, three second year post graduate students from our college have received a total amount of ₹ 1,11,600 from which each received ₹ 36,200 annually.															

•	Under the scheme of PG Indira Gandhi Scholarship for Single Girl Child, seven PG second year students of our college have received a total of ₹ 2,53,400 from which each received ₹ 36,200.
•	A total of 128 students have applied under the scheme of National Scholarship for Post Graduate Studies offered by the University Board of Trustees. Among them, selected students will receive ₹ 1,50,000 per annum.
•	The Central Government Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education provides scholarship under “Central Sector Scheme of Scholarship for College and University Students”. Currently 353 students studying in the second and third year have received ₹ 42,36,000 from which each got ₹ 12,000 each year. 214 first year students of this year have applied for this scheme.
