

Create an interface which is user friendly to both the students and the administrator. The administrator can keep track of the records of each student in the Summative External MCQ Examination.

## Module Description

1. Administrator
2. Student

### Administrator

- The administrator has the complete privileges over the data.
- They can manage the details of the departments, courses, subjects, and the students.
- They can conduct subject-wise scheduling for the students as per the curriculum of the current academic year by specifying the date and time and being able to fetch the result in document format (PDF, Excel).
- They can grant permission to attend the exam only when they have paid the fee for the summative examination, otherwise they can revoke them.

### Student

- They can log in with the following credentials: RollNumber and Dateofbirth.
- The test link will be automatically available when the exam time starts as per the administrator schedule.
- When the MCQ test link is available, they can attempt the test by choosing their desired option and submit the test.
- At the time of submission they will get the success message from the server.
- They have to complete the test within the specified time limit, otherwise the test will be automatically submitted.

- Test links are automatically open on the given date, starting time and the ending time or the administrator can manually open and close the test.
- Test status is moved to the archive once it is completed

## Students

- Add the students based on the department and semester.
- List and Manage the current students and arrear students.
- Arrear students list does not have the semester data.

## Result

- View the result of each test in pdf and excel format
- The results can have the following details: student roll number, name, count of the correct and wrong answers, total score, and the total number of attempts they made.

## Question Selection Method

- Each Subject has 150 questions.
- Each Exam has 50 questions and each correct answer carries 0.5 marks.
- To randomize the question order, 3 types of question sets are prepared and randomly assigned for each student.
- The selection of 50 questions for the exam is based on the following method

Unit	Start Index	End Index
Unit I	1	30
Unit II	31	60
Unit III	61	90
Unit IV	91	120
Unit V	121	150

### Procedure in selecting the Question Sets

- First Set
  - Collect the first 10 questions from each unit and we have obtained a total count of 50 questions from all the units
- Second Set
  - Collect the second 10 questions from each unit and we have obtained a total count of 50 questions from all the units
- Third Set
  - Collect the third 10 questions from each unit and we have obtained a total count of 50 questions from all the units

### Question Display Method

**STEP 1:** In the allotted Computer, the Login Page of MCQ Exam is displayed:









**STEP 3:** In the DASHBOARDS, in the **Exams List**, Click **Today's Exam**

Create an interface which is user friendly to both the students and the administrator. The administrator can keep track of the records of each student in each ERL Examination.

## Module Description

1. Administrator
2. Student

### Administrator

- The administrator has the complete privileges over the data.
- They can manage the details of the departments, courses, subjects, and the students.
- They can conduct subject-wise scheduling for the students as per the curriculum of the current academic year by specifying the date and time and being able to fetch the result in document format (PDF, Excel).
- They can grant and revoke the permissions of the students when needed.

### Student

- They can log in with the following credentials: RollNumber and Dateofbirth.
- The test links of all the ERL subjects will be automatically available when the exam time starts as per the administrator schedule.
- When the MCQ test link is available, they can attempt each ERL test by choosing their desired option and submit the test.
- At the time of submission they will get the success message from the server.
- They have to complete the test within the specified time limit, otherwise the test will be automatically submitted.
- After submitting the first test, they have to attempt the remaining available tests within the available time.

### **ERL Setup**

- Choose the department and semester which gives the matched class list.
- Get the subjects from the subject list based on the department and semester.
- Set the order of the ERL to be conducted, in certain cases the units covered during the lecture classes may differ. For example, in a particular class unit-3 is completed in the beginning and after the completion of unit-3 other units may get covered.

### **Exam**

- Create a test with a unique name by specifying the date, start time, end time, description, department, semester, subject name.
- After test creation, administrators can manually select the students who are eligible to write the test at the specific time and eliminate the students who are not eligible.

### **Question Chosen Method**

- Each Subject has 150 questions.
- For each ERL subject, the exam is designed based on the following setup given in the table.
- 10 questions are selected from each unit which is based on the ERL order specified by the administrator.

Unit III	61	90
Unit IV	91	120
Unit V	121	150

### ERL Set

- For each ERL, 10 questions are selected from a set of 30 questions by identifying the start limit and end limit of each unit. Totally 3 sets of questions are formed for each unit.
- At the student point of view, only 10 questions are displayed.

### Question Display Method

- Within the specified time, if any issues persist the students are allowed to take the maximum of 3 attempts.
- For each student, the question sets can be displayed in a randomized order and each student has to attend 10 questions from each subject.
- They have to complete the test before the specified time, if they failed to do so then the submission will happen automatically.
- The unattempted questions will not be taken for grading and each correct answer carries 1 mark.
- After submission, students can view the answer key of each subject
  - Correct
  - Wrong
  - Unattempted

### Needs to be analyzed

- In the Subject Question table, we do **not have a unit number field**. If there is a need to delete a question in the middle (Say, Question number:25) then the newly added question will append at the end of the subject question table. So as per the present procedure, if we consider the first 30 questions as the first unit then the content of the second unit will appear in the 30th position, so there is a possibility of rendering a wrong question. **So it is necessary to make sure that the order of questions does not change at any instance.**
- To make the system flawless, we have to add the Unit Number field to the existing entry which will solve the rendering issue and provide a provision to add more number of questions to each unit without any restrictions.
